Tax Credit Scholarship Program

State approved non-profit organizations may receive donations from individuals or corporations to help pay for a child's private education. These non-profits are called Scholarship Granting Organizations (SGO) and currently provide scholarships to thousands of Hoosier students throughout the state.

How to apply for the Tax Credit Scholarship:

- 1 Determine if your student (between the ages of 5-22) is eligible based on income requirements (see table below). Kindergarteners must be 5 by August 1.
- 2 Choose an eligible school that best meets your child's needs.
- 3 Submit the application to your school.
- 4 Submit income verification documents to the school.
