A Commitment to Service

Each family registered at Holy Trinity Catholic School is asked to complete a minimum of 10 hours of service during the current academic year. Service hours can be completed for Holy Trinity Catholic School, the family's parish/church, or the local community. Service hours may be completed by parents or grandparents. Student service hours may count if completed outside of the school day.

When completing the online registration through PowerSchool, families will check a box, indicating that they agree to the policies set forth in this Family Service Handbook. Throughout the school year, each family will receive a quarterly letter, showing how many hours have been completed to date. An End of the Year Summary Report for each family will be run on May 1st. At that time, **failure to complete the service hours will result in an assessment of \$20 for each hour not completed up to \$200.**

Dependability:

The school relies on your support. We ask that you follow through with your commitment to serve by arriving on time or giving advance notice of an absence.

Confidentiality:

Those who serve operate in a position of trust. Personal information pertaining to students must be kept confidential. Children's actions, responses, progress or problems at school are not for sharing in the community. Conversations between parents, teachers and students in the school are confidential. Those who serve should not discuss these conversations outside of school. Please refer any concerns to the Administration.

Dress:

Holy Trinity Catholic School has a dress code. Although there is no dress code requirement while serving, it is expected that everyone reflects the image of Holy Trinity Catholic School and wears modest clothing while working in the school or during school activities. This includes a moderate length for skirts and shorts and conservative blouses and tops.

Service Opportunities:

This list contains service activities and events that take place throughout the school year. Additional activities and events may be shared through the School Newsletter. Families will receive 1 service hour for every hour of time that is donated to the various activities.
